Well, Merrill Lynch is actually a division of Bank of America because Bank of America bought them out during the 08 financial collapse. So who owns Bank of

America? Well, nowadays, Warren Buffett is the top shareholder of bank America because he owns Berkshire Hathaway, which is his billionaire investment firm. I'm still not sure what this top one is. This 25% that's an anomaly, and I cannot corroborate what those shares are, but I found these shares. This is a

screenshot from Berkshire Hathaway's 13 f where they tell you all the things they hold. And I totaled up all of these Bank of America shares, and it equals 1,032,000,000 shares. That's 13% of Bank of America shares equal to \$33 billion but I also dug in a little bit into where Bank of America came from,

and who found our Amedeo Giannini, who acquired what was then called banca de America d'Italia, sorry for that accent. Over the years, it changed its name to bank America, and then, in the biggest merger in history, merged with Charlotte based nation bank in 1990 what, 1998 so I just thought it was

In its first 10 years, Aladdin was fed information about every asset price movement and risk variable in the global bond market Larry's specialty. And in

1999 when Aladdin turned 11, Aladdin was getting so intelligent at big losers and winners that Larry began selling access to his data to other Wall Street firms. That same year, he took Blackrock public on the New York Stock Exchange straight after the IPO the.com bust burst, pushing a wall of money

from the stock market to bonds, which Aladdin had become the undisputed world champion in. Within years, Blackrock had become a trillion dollar company, and as money started shifting back to shares, what did Larry do? He bought the asset management arm of Merrill Lynch, which was focused at

shares. good effect that the scales of victory could only incline toward the allies. And so Netta had become the goddess of a new strong peace, which was to deliver mankind from the morass of the foregoing century, but she was also this, well, everyone that was actually chapter one of umbra's book

project Mars, a technical tale, and I would like all of you to kind of just consume and re-listen, if you may, to the words of The first introductory chapter. Chapter one will begin on Tuesday, and we are trying to make it happen, because I couldn't speak for a while. I am still a little bit impaired, but

And as you all know, YouTube, Google banned me

We must understand where we are at we are watching rallies with AI. We are watching people that

possibly don't even exist as members of a cabinet that are simply on a television. You've already seen the AI newscasters coming out of Asia, they look real. It's very hard for people to understand, you know, that there there are more layers. There's a reason that it's called the onion network, for a

reason there is a layer within a layer. I've explained this many times, and it is very interesting to see that the goals that they have set are the same goals that the former Nazi scientist who then defected to the United States that helped build rockets wrote a book about this highly specific to exactly

what is coming to I hope you guys enjoy this series as it is quite important that we understand it. Now, before I go today, I just wanted to make a couple of you know observations. The news cycle has been extremely slow. It is extremely toxic. And as you know, for years, I have been watching

If not, it's best that I did not, because it was one thing that I never wanted to speak the reality. But we are seeing a lot of people starting to fall into that, where they're trying to

Where are they? Speaking up for those that aren't being that aren't able to speak. No one

said a word about Christianity, Orthodox Christianity being banned from a nation. And you know how you control a nation? I've told you this example before. I actually wrote about it in 2018 Do you guys remember Peter Schrock right? So Peter Schrock's father and Barack Hussein Obama's mom, Sam Leann

Dunham, she raised him so she's his mother. They went on to create Iran that you know today, well, that you knew a couple months ago, because it's totally changed. How did we do that? By changing their religion. See, before this revolution in Iran, right, women were wearing miniskirts. They were out and

about. They had clubs. They were forward thinking, even though they weren't get this Muslim, not Muslim. Muslim. Their religion was not Sharia. Sharia was invented to control the population. The same thing with Afghanistan. See if you actually look at pictures of Afghanistan and Iran and all these nations

that you know are bad you. You'll notice that it was the United States that kind of came to help and, well, it's not just the United States. It's five eyes, right? We're talking England. We're talking us. We're talking Australia, right? New Zealand, right? All of these people are involved in

everything. If you can destroy religion of a nation or shape it to a controlling way, and you win. And before the color revolution, and before we rigged their elections in Ukraine, what did we do? We told them, Oh, you got to get rid of your church. You can change it to the PCU. It was the most weird thing I've

They've got

the difference between Coptic, Greek, Russian, well, the Copts are a little bit, I identify with them more, but the Russian, the Greek, the Romanian, the Ethiopians, know, well, they're different too. So they're like super Christian, because they actually live the words don't just repeat them,

but they're all the same, except for the language. Ukrainian Orthodox Christians make these really nice cakes for Easter. They have their own little traditions. I mean, they do something like that in Russia, but the Ukrainian ones are just so cool. And the thing is, their their Congress. You know,

however you want to call it, Congress, Parliament, whatever, they applauded that. They removed religion that has been a part of their heritage for eons. They banned OG Christianity and allowed some new one that was concocted by a couple of nerds at the State Department in 2012 they signed it, and so it is the

most insane dynamic I've seen. Maybe this is why I've been put on my ass, because I would have said a lot of very harsh things to a lot of people that think they're important. You know, religion is very personal, and religion should never be altered. You can pray and and see God the way you wish. You

want to be a Satanist. Go ahead and do it. That's on you, right? But we shouldn't ban it, because then that makes us no different from the people that are banning Christianity, or, you know, Islam or Judaism, or whatever you want to call, any of these religions, we have no right to sit there and ban things and

then again, all these people that are Christian, all these Anons that I see, oh, Christian, none of them spoke about it. Now, man, the hypocrisy is real, because when you don't speak for people that cannot, when you don't defend your God, right now, what is it? Martyr for your God? I'm not saying to go kill

yourself, but you know what I mean, when you don't stand for what you say, your words mean absolutely nothing. And so as a people, what were we shocked? What were they doing at the Olympics just a couple weeks ago, mocking Christianity? Did Israel come out and make a comment? Obviously not. But we

did see Iran do that because they're a country that have been plagued with religion changes, right? That suits leadership very well. It's a great control mechanism. We saw nations that actually have religions other than Christianity. Call it appalling, yet our Allies did not too, and we're talking

Christian allies and non Christian allies. Africans were pissed. They were like, we don't even want to look at it. They pulled people out of it. They pulled money out of it. Oh, what I like to call very lukewarm Christians, fake, fake, fake. Fake. We're all your prophets talking about this shit. Huh?

You throw all the views and all the money to these people that are creating all this content telling you about how God speaks to them. Did God not tell them? Hey, they're banning religion that is at the core mine, or, I guess, maybe their new version. And is more graceful than yours, right? Because, you know, it's

always being upgraded, and this will ring a very good understanding to the simulation that all these big names keep talking about, and no one seems to know what it is. It's quite specific and quite interesting, and it's exceptional. I might add machine, analytical reconstitution and analysis

simulation. Repeat those words until you understand what that means. One portion. So now that we've I've sat and watched the media not talk about religion, the Christian Orthodox religion being banned. Have some smart ass who always posts like religious content say, Oh yeah. It's not about the masks. It's about parental rights, even though I'm arguing the masks. So parental rights doesn't have to

do with the masks, does it? No, but the case has to do same thing with Roe versus Wade. What did that case when it actually was in their favor and upheld? Is a valid argument give them centralized power to make decisions and impose laws to all states and people of the United States that's foregoing a lot of

power to very few hands if people in a certain state want to have abortions. They can run for office locally, and if their state decides and they pass a law, then they can do that in their state. They have made this argument about abortion and Roe versus Wade, ridiculous. And you know, to dumb people, smart

people sound dumb. They do when they're really the dumb ones. They're really, really the dumb ones. You know, now George Bush is speaking, so obviously the demplicants have made their ascension. So thank you for that Bush Jr, showing the world that there is one party, and that party is the unit party, and

then we have the die hard road with idiots, where you have people in office that. Power to do something, and are doing absolutely nothing. she is going through for all of us, and in the end, it'll be okay. But it's really hard when you're in the position of taking the heat and someone's telling you what's going to be fine. But I speak from experience, I had a lot of people telling me it'll be fine. And I was thinking, what the heck? But they were

right. No one can make God's plans change. Only he can. He's so awesome, you can't even think what he's coming up with next. Think about it. They're not here for you. Think about it. Your elections are run on who makes the most money and raises the most funds. Think about it, it's who gives you the most oohs and

ahs. Think about it. We're at this point where we're literally in a simulation. We're being messed with. I mean, you can't even make up half of this stuff. did was take painkillers and sleep all day, and in the meantime, you know, I lost my phone as well, obviously, because I was out of it, I had contractors going in and out of my house, and I was watching the news, and all I was doing was like, Oh my God, but I didn't have the energy to do anything.

I just wanted to not not do anything. I wanted to just not respond, not say much, keep it simple, because I was not okay with it. I was really not okay with it. I know a lot of you have put in a lot of time and effort on the things that you've done your foyers are all coming in very slowly. And remember,

Justice comes in on a donkey always. But it's important for us to remember that we are the writers of our own story, your story, your you. So let's say, for example, Perseus, who's I just saw a name on a chat your story, your pen, you write it. Now. And obviously there are external factors, like the

selected officials, the laws they've created, the corruption, the box that we're in, you know today, even I have been shocked for for weeks now, where you know, aside from the BS that I'm going through after this tornado, which you know, the aftermath is worse than when it happened. I would have just

liked it to just have been trees and rubbish and holes in my siding. It's like, going to the supermarket. You're just like, What the heck. How am I supposed to eat? It's so expensive, a good thing. I have a sugar daddy boyfriend, but it's so expensive. It is expensive. I even have a little garden and to

offset costs. And it's very expensive. The world is going to hell in a handbasket. And we have people playing popularity games, and, you know, trying to, you know, pull one up. And I've been watching these affinity groups, they're so upset because they're like, Dude, I mean, that's a smart idea, but we're

not doing it. You know, we're not, um, we're not doing they're discussing, I'm in their private chats, and they actually called out the right wing people that are organizing these weird setups that you're seeing outside the DNC, it is the most appalling thing I've ever seen. So it's a good thing that I was

so it's a good thing that I was kind of knocked out for a bed, because I would have been a vicious cunt online.

Vicious, vicious beyond belief. All I did was share things and make a couple comments when I was up and awake for, like, whatever, one two hours in between. You know, taking my medication, that's how pain, how much pain I've been in, I didn't become septic, so that's good. It was almost there. Well, I was

kind and but not really. I cannot even watch anymore. Like, what the right wing? We don't even have a right wing media. There is no right wing. It's the same freaking it's two wings of the same, corrupt, disgusting bird. I just listened to my president, that's it, and what he points to, we have the we

have no outlet but to be our own. It's It's horrific. I see people in so much pain and confusion. It's just, I don't know what to say anymore. All I can do is pray. And I want to thank all of you for praying for me, for helping me. Thank you. I You have no idea. So I see a lot of people are asking me. So

okay, so after the tornado on the aftermath right, we got all the trees done. I was posting videos at that time. I was like, I wasn't in. I was sick, but not that bad. Got really bad, actually a week ago, but I remember all these people coming in to check the house, and apparently the whole siding has

to change because there's holes here, and they don't make it, and they don't do this. And then so where there's Redwood that I don't even have a redwood near my property, so God knows where it came from. That smashed down near my septic, and other trees smashed down by there, right? It actually cracked because

plumbing pipes back in the days were just, like a couple feet underground, and they would use cast iron. So it actually, like, cracked a pipe because there was, like a part of a tree that was like inside the the you know, and now it's like, my backyard has, like, we can't even use the bathroom there on

that side of the house, because it's coming out. It's not going to the septic, it's just in the garden. It's like the most insane stuff. And then trees have been falling after the fact too. So now my front fence is gone because another tree decided to fall. Then next door to me. They're constructing

something. So they had, like a fence with a barrier. And since they're making like some hill or some other stuff, they put like a barrier for water. And then some of my trees fell on their side of the property, which crushed it. That almost flooded my property too. So it's just been like horrible one after

another. Turns out there's, there's just so much stuff. It's just, and it's and, you know what else sucks, like my electricals, for example. Let me give you an example. The electricians that I, that I use to actually change my electricals, I think they rob me blind. I can't wait to write a

review, because I don't write reviews right away until one. Work is done, or did I like your work? And they came to quote me for the meters that were ripped off my walls for two meters, even though I had three, they quoted me \$5,100 and I needed those meters on before anything, before even your presence, came

to me, I needed to get those done. So I was like, Okay, I'm gonna max out my credit card and we're just gonna get it done. But my boyfriend was like, listen, I know you don't like me getting involved in your matters. I know this, but let me call around. Well, we got a real electrician to come, and He did

all of them for \$3,500 dude, they price gouge when you're desperate. I even have this one company, and I think it's important that I say this, because this is this just shows the core of humanity and where they're at. There's like companies that are restoration companies, right? So then your

insurance gives you list, and you call them, because my deck is broken, my porch is broken. My gutters were ripped. On one side, part of my little roof on that side has been damaged. Another side of the house, gutters, like it's terrible. This guy comes, he takes a bunch of pictures and looks at it,

and, you know, my fence is gone, all that stuff. And he takes a picture and everything, and then he's like, All right, well, when's the adjuster coming? I'm like, well, the adjusters coming on the 19th of August. He's like, All right, well, let me know when he gets his report. So he calls me, and mind you, I was

on a Percocet, so I give myself full freedom for the ear bashing that I gave him. But he calls me, and he was like, so did he tell you how much, how much your budget is to fix stuff? And I was like, I'm sorry. Excuse me. He's like, you could give me the number. I'll contact him. He'll give me the budget, and we'll

just fix stuff. And I said, I'm sorry. Hold on. A second Wait. How does this work again? He goes, Well, you know, I've taken pictures. I know everything that needs to be done. We'll advocate for you if they want to go cheap on this, or if we need more money for this, or whatever, but we'll, we'll see what they have,

house there, and they're not going to have power like, this isn't okay. Actors, why didn't you recommend someone? He goes, Yeah, you know, I was like, you know, because it would have been nice if you helped, like, giving me some direction while I'm trying to call people in their price gouging. And they're all

like, busy, right? So they're only going to the places that are going to pay the top dollar. I was actually quite lucky with the guy that Al found, because then I still wouldn't have power, because they're all booked out, because everyone was destroyed, and apparently, now my insurance has me in something

called catastrophic, whatever that means it's the most insane thing, right? Most insane thing. I have never seen humanity so bad. And I'll tell you what that electrician that came was a breath of freaking fresh air. And the arborist that came from Butler pa northern arborist, my gosh, they were incredible. My

yard looked like nothing ever happened, except for, like, the stumps in the in the hole in the floor, everything they even tried to, you know, we had chicken wire behind the fence, right? They actually put that up something. My dogs don't jump off the ravine. They did such an incredible job, such an

incredible job, and came out in that's where you're like. Oh my gosh. Like, thank you for this, and I was such a bad host, by the way, on the last day they were here, because it took them two days to clear my my yard, two days I was the worst because I was feeling a lot of pain. And when I tell you pain like it

was, it was supposedly an old root canal from get this, 2000 freaking eight. I had more than one root in one tooth and three roots in the other. They only did two roots, one in each, so I had the other roots just hanging out. So I having an underlying inflammation. And that would make sense, because sometimes my

gums would be sore, or I would feel bad. I'd have inflammation constantly, because that root canal was never done to the point that my face swelled that I couldn't even see out of my eye. That's how bad it was. It was so bad. And the thing is, the day of the tornado was it the day of the tornado? The next

day after the tornado, I finally got an appointment with a dentist, because they're always booked out, and if it's an emergency, you just go and they patch you up. And I needed someone not only to patch me up, but to be like, you know, my ear hurt, and it's been months that I've had a headache and earache,

but kind of wash it off, which means I have a pretty good immune system if I've been battling this for a couple years, according to this dentist. So it was really bad, like I had never tasted pus before. I did for the first time. Never experienced a dentist with a scalpel in my

mouth. Did it for the first time.

They cut my gums on the inner and outer portion. They put a hole in my tooth, and it was just bleeding, like my mouth. It was just so bad. It was so bad. You guys, I would never, like, I've been through childbirth. Okay, fine. They were C sections. But the second one, I was actually going through labor

pains, because she was, like, way overdue, and I could feel that rock between my legs for those women that have given birth, you know what I'm talking about. That's That's nothing. I've been impaled by a piece of car, and that didn't hurt as bad as that. Like my eye I couldn't see my ear was hurting my face,

like I even sprained my neck, guys, because I was like, sleeping with my hand, my palm underneath my chin to prop my head up so that my face doesn't touch the pillow by accident. Like, that's how bad it was. And like I said, I on Friday, when I went back last Friday to the dentist, it had gotten worse,

like, just exposing from the tooth. So he had to cut my gums and do a lot of stuff. And then it was just terrible. And then on Monday, when I got there, I was so high he didn't even need to put a needle in my mouth to put, like, a temporary filling to then come back, because we needed me to complete this

rigorous freaking antibiotic regimen, which was insane. I'm like, on my second round now it that's how bad it is. So it was the most worst thing ever. You know, worse I never and it was bad timing. It was like I was so put on my ass, like I my boyfriend didn't even see me. All I would do is sleep or sleep

at my desk, trying to engage with the digital community. I actually was trying to play some Age of Empires too, and I was like, starting the game, and then I forgot I was in a game because I was that out of it. I've never been out like that in my life. So I have to say it's, it's it's not memorable. That's

true. So on that note, I will be going to our nation's capital. I will be there for the next few days for some stuff, and Tuesday, I am hoping that my new producer right is that it Tex will do just fine with the audio that I will be sending him in snippets now that I can open my mouth without hurting so and I

want to thank everyone who reached out for help. I want to thank Jamie was on my campaign, really good friend of mine. She had given me a lot of eggs that really helped, because it couldn't eat and also to Jocelyn, like, she offered, hey, we're coming with saws. And Michael, like, all of these

people were just coming to and I wasn't even able to accept it, because I couldn't even think, like, I lost my phone, you guys. Like, literally, I've had no phone for like, four days, and I'm I didn't go anywhere except for the dentist, so I have no idea where I put it. It might have gone out in the trash, so I

had to use an old device that's kind of working. It's so bad, so bad. So I hope you guys enjoyed this over. Or tomorrow, what I'll do is I'll upload just that episode ad 1980 onto locals part of a playlist so you have it forever with no commentary or comments on it. And I want to wish you all a fantastic

evening. Please don't lower yourself to the standards of others. I'm learning that, especially when people target me, I want to lower myself to their standards and be a bitch. Sometimes I give in to that because it's a really bad, guilty pleasure. You know, at some point, God's going to be
